CHRISTIANS ARE FINDING IT INCREASINGLY DIFFICULT TO DISCUSS THEIR BELIEFS WITHIN THE WIDER CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY AND TO THOSE OUTSIDE THEIR FAITH.

WHILE, "FAITH AND SPIRITUALITY" ARE STILL VERY IMPORTANT TOPICS WITHIN OUR SOCIETY, "FAITH IN THE AMERICAN CONTEXT HAS NOW BECOME INDIVIDUAL AND CUSTOMIZED."

75% say faith is becoming more important in their lives & 45% would be willing to try a new church or new form of church

THIS OPENNESS TO "FAITH" BRINGS NEW CHALLENGES

71% say they will develop their own slate of beliefs rather than accept a package of structured beliefs

People are comfortable with the idea of being "spiritual" as opposed to "devoutly Christian"

Only 34% believe in absolute moral truth

WITHIN THE CHURCH
 (SELF-IDENTIFIED CHRISTIANS)

Most are comfortable with the idea that the Bible and other sacred books teach the same truths and principles

50% firmly believe that the Bible is totally accurate in all of the principles (not facts) that it teaches

36% strongly agree that it is important for followers of Christ to maintain positive relationships with non-Christians

Little progress, if any, is being made toward assisting people to become biblically literate
